

Steps of TK series manually installing USB driver

1. Right-click My Computer on the desktop, and select [Manage] in the pop-up right-click menu. As shown below:



2. Find the "device manager" option in the pop-up computer management window, as shown in the figure below:





3. Find the unrecognized USB serial port in the device manager, right-click the serial port and select [Update Driver], as shown in the figure below.





4. In the pop-up dialog box, select "Browse my computer for find driver software", as shown in the figure below:
